

#### Marker's responsibilities

Although we are not able to swap cards with our marker, please note that you are still responsible for verifying your playing partner's score. It's not always possible, but you should try to observe, where you can, your partner's shots so that you are able to agree the total number of strokes on each hole, including any penalties.
