## Captain's Comments

Welcome to 2021!! Tuesday 2 February will be Opening Day of our main (winter) season of golf for 2021. This will also be the start of our Birdie and Gobbler Competitions and the 9 Hole Eclectic. The 18 hole Eclectic will start up on 5 February once the 8th hole is reopened. Despite it being barely 6 weeks since the close of last year's winter season we have had a lot on our minds (Christmas, New Year, worldwide pandemic....) so I feel it is good to refresh our memories with regard to a few things:

#### **Tuesday competitions**

- Sign in sheets will open 15 days in advance at 4.30pm starting on 19 January for Opening Day (2 February).
- Women's Committee members will compile the draw each week from that date. The draw will be posted on the website one week beforehand for Stableford and Par events and 4 days before Stroke Rounds. Please note that Stroke Days are played in Division and Handicap order.
- The 18 hole competition will commence at 7.30am from both tees.
- The 18 hole pm competition will continue from the 1st tee from 11.30am.
- The 9 hole competition will commence at 11.30am from the 10th tee with timesheets opening 8 days in advance at 4.30pm.

#### Friday competitions

- Timesheets will open 8 days in advance at 4.30pm. You put your name down on the time you wish to play.
- The 18 hole competition will commence at 7.40am from the 1st tee.
- The 9 hole competition will continue to run from the 10th tee throughout February due to summer heat.

## **Australia Day**

Australia Day this year falls on a Tuesday. As with every Public Holiday, the competition format will be an Individual and 2B Medley. The Australia Day theme is Aussie BBQ so dress in your best Aussie BBQ attire! Brolin will be preparing a delicious BBQ so please come along. The timesheet will open on Tuesday 19 January at 6.00am.

## **New Members Day**

New Members Day is on Friday 5 February. This is an opportunity to meet and welcome any of our 38 women members who have joined since February 2020 (so some of you are not exactly 'new'). The format of the day will be a fun 4 Ball Team Ambrose for both the 18 hole and 9 hole players with Longest Drives and Nearest the Pins for one and all.

Scones will be served after 9 holes for the morning 18 hole players, or before you tee off for the 9 hole players and the afternoon 18 hole players. Timesheets will open as usual 8 days in advance at 4.30pm but there will only be 3 spaces available per line.

**New Members** - please do not put your names on the timesheet - there will be a separate sign in sheet for you, from which we will put your names onto the draw. This year our New Women Members also have the option of playing on the Saturday Jan 30th New Members Day. On this day New Members play for the Fred Dand Memorial Trophy which is awarded to the player with the Best Stableford Score of a member who joined in the previous 12 months. The timesheet will open this Saturday 23rd January at 6am. Please be aware that the timesheet is likely to fill very quickly as we have a lot of new members as well as the usual Saturday players and semi final of the Men's Fourball Knockout on that day.

#### 1st Round GNSW Medals

9 February will be our first stroke round of the year and the first round of the Golf NSW Medal Competition. A fee of \$5 will be charged to the House Account of anyone who wishes to be eligible to win a monthly medal or go on to represent Roseville at the Metropolitan Final at the end of the year. Please let the Pro Shop staff know when you pay your comp fee on 9 February if you do not wish to participate otherwise \$5 will be automatically deducted from your House Account. Full details of the GNSW Medal Competition are posted on the noticeboard outside the Women's Committee Room.

For anyone who is a little worried about playing a stroke round, please remember there is a Drop Down Stableford available on any of our stroke days and the 9 hole competition is always Stableford on a stroke day.

## **Singles Knockout**

Tuesday, 9 February is also the qualifying day for our Singles Knockout which is our first major club event. Please note that quarter- and semi-finals will be played on the subsequent Tuesdays at the beginning of the afternoon with the 18 hole comp. The final will be played on Tuesday 9 March. The full conditions of play are displayed on the noticeboard outside the Women's Committee Room.

Please note: **you MUST circle the "YES"** on your scorecard if you wish to qualify. Members who do not indicate either 'YES" or "NO" will be regarded as NOT qualifying. If you are considering representing Roseville in the Pennant Competition this year, the Singles Knockout is an excellent way to brush up on your match play skills. Please come and see me if you have any questions about this competition.

#### **Pennants**

I would like to thank Amanda Halstead for offering to act as Pennants Co-ordinator again this year. She is presently organising our Silver II team, who play their first match on 12 February. Please keep an eye on the noticeboard outside the Women's Committee Room.
